Why science communication matters

- » Building bridge between research and society
- » Giving a voice to local communities
- » Greenland's National Research Strategy emphasizes the importance of inclusive, community-centered research





What is KINDLE?

- » science and outreach project
- » paleoclimate, cave exploration and geology in Greenland
- » short-term goal: introduce Greenlanders to their remote yet beautiful caves in the north, communicate research results
- » long-term goal: engage Greenlanders to join, collaborate, and ideally lead future cave exploration





ILLU Science & Art Hub

- » operated by the University of Bergen
- » part of the broader Climate Narratives project -> communicating climate change through multiple forms of storytelling
- » Open house concept
- » Interactive exhibition, workshops for kids and adults, Q&As






